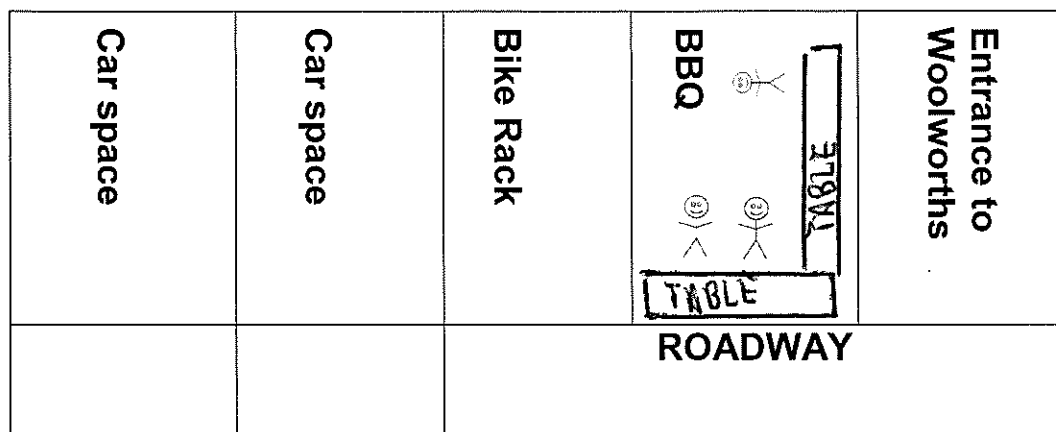

Location

Just outside back entrance to Woolworths Fairy Meadow, on the concrete slab near the bike rack.

Enter car park from Daisy Street.

Set Up Layout



Location of BBQ + 2 x TABLES

- Stored in the Staff Room at the back of Woolworths
- Go to far end corner of the supermarket – walk through pop up door – turn left and walk into Staff Room
- Push the BBQ through the Supermarket aisles to our location
- Please ensure BBQ is “cleaned” before returning it to the Staff room at 2pm
- BBQ is the property of Rotary Club of Fairy Meadow

Ice

Put Ice Buckets in a trolley and go around to Harley and John Seafood. Pay **them \$10** and they fill up the buckets with ice for our soft drinks. **Keep receipts please.**

If you need to get more ice (doubtful) just go back to H & J and they'll refill the container @ no-charge.

Gas Bottle

The club has purchased its own gas bottle and Tony McAdam will always ensure that it is full. It is kept at **Harley & John Seafood**. Just ask for it when you get the ice.

Cardboard For BBQ

Please place cardboard pieces under BBQ to prevent possible staining of concrete.

Menu

There is a **“Menu”** of various “options” available to customers. Just place them out on the table for people to see prices.

Tables

Main: Display Drink Can Options – sauce options, serviettes, tray with food, bread etc

Side: Put all your “incidentals” on there (bread etc)

Drink Buckets: Place on ground just to the side of main table near Woolworths Door Entrance.

N.B.

Drinks have NOT been a big seller at our BBQ’s so no need to put stacks in the ice buckets.

Food items for BBQ.

Everything is purchased on the morning on a **“Buy as you need it” basis**, eliminating “wastage” at the end of the 4 hours.

All items are purchased at the **lowest possible price** (i.e. “No Name” or “House” Brands).

If you are not sure where the various items are, just ask a Staff Member and they’ll point you in the right area.

The following quantities are based on May’s Purchases – and should save you having to go back into the supermarket too many times to replenish stocks.

Product	Item	Approx Cost
Eggs	2 Cartons	\$2.79 per carton
Minute Steak	1 Packet	\$8.99 a packet
Bread	6 Loaves	\$0.85c a loaf
Bacon	2 Packets	\$8.00 a packet
Sausages	3 Packets of 24	\$7.50 a packet
Onions	3 Packets Sliced and/or diced onions (freezer section)	\$2.10 a bag

Float

Always leave **\$150** in the “Float” to change money from customers.

Payments For Food Stuffs - Ice

1. Team Leader that day – please pay for all items out of your own pocket initially.
2. Keep all receipts and place in Money Box
3. **At the conclusion , deduct your expenses from that day’s BBQ Takings, and leave balance in the plastic bag in the Money Box**
4. Takings – Expenses = what we made that day from the BBQ!

Collection and Return of Items Needed For BBQ

Collect and return to Tony’s Place – 21 Sheringa Grove Cordeaux Heights. 0414 426 367.

If I’m not at home, just leave everything in back area near my garage – don’t worry! No one will steal anything!

Left Over Food Stuffs

If there is a spare loaf of bread or some eggs etc – just take them home yourselves.

If you’d like me to freeze some of the sausages or bacon or steaks for next time, just let me know (leave me a note, if I’m not at home when you return).

But we’ve found that **by about 1.40pm**, depending on crowd numbers, just encourage shoppers to buy **what’s still on the bbq**, rather than start cooking new food.

What To Bring With You

Apron, tongs and if possible wear your Club Polo Shirt please.
